











RESTAURANT MEALS PROGRAM

For Elderly, Disabled and Homeless CalFresh Recipients



This program is available to you and your husband or wife if you receive CalFresh and are:

- Elderly (age 60 or older) or
- Disabled (See CalFresh Program Guide 63-390 for definition) or
- Homeless.

The Restaurant Meals Program (RMP) allows you to use your Cal-Fresh benefits to purchase prepared food from restaurants participating in the Restaurant Meals Program. The County will determine your eligibility to the program and code your Golden State Advantage (EBT) card so that it may be accepted as payment for meals at participating restaurants.

Purchasing Meals is easy

- 1. Look for participating restaurants displaying the Restaurant Meals Program sign.
- 2. Purchase breakfast, lunch or dinner from participating restaurants by using your EBT card.
- 3. Receive a receipt to show the cost of your meal and the balance on your EBT account.
